1 Version 2.7.4 Release Notes

Version 2.7.4 is mostly a bug-fix release to 2.7 (and some additional fixes since 2.7.3). This document contains all notable changes since 2.7.

To upgrade to this release, you only need to install it over your current version. There is no need to uninstall the previous version. All previous versions will be upgraded automatically -- you do not need to install previous upgrades before this one, and all of your data and settings will be retained (except for the "demo" database file, which will be replaced with a new version).

Networking Note: Be sure that all workstations are upgraded at the same time (shut down all workstations, upgrade all of them, then restart them one by one starting with the master workstation).

Note: You cannot go back to using your database with a version of Campground Master prior to 2.7 once you start using this version, due to upgrades that are automatically made to the database. Be sure you make a backup of the database before installing the new version, in case you have any trouble.

Also Note: When you install the new version, the "**demo**" database (demo.prk) will be overwritten with a new version of the sample database. If you have been working with the sample database and want to save the changes you've made, then you need to load it and then use <u>File</u> | <u>Save As</u> to save it to a different name before installing the new version of the software.

Version 2.7.4 release changes:

- Fixes implemented -- Bugs fixed since the 2.7 version release.
- Other changes -- Other changes since 2.7.

2 Fixes implemented

Fixes in 2.7.3:

- Site Details -- The Notes field was not being saved when changed on Site Details.
- Rates -- Auto-rates were not using the entire stay's length when filtering for "Applies to >= days" (was only counting the days in the rate's season instead of the whole reservation range).
- Networking -- is was not synchronizing immediately after a Quote/Confirmation function (in Reservation Details), which could result in some out-of-sequence issues (and thus creating orphaned transactions).
- Transactions -- It was automatically setting paid-thru to the end even if the paid-thru date was changed manually.
- P.O.S. -- It would crash when adding items if the net qty of items was 0 (e.g. add qty 1 and then add qty -1).
- P.O.S. -- It was adding discount transactions even if the quantity was 0 (now it removes the discount transaction properly).
- P.O.S. -- It was not properly removing discounts when items are voided.
- P.O.S. -- Access level to "Return Items" would allow the return, but if the level for "Enter negative charges" isn't high enough then it wouldn't allow saving it.
- P.O.S. -- The "amount taxed" shown for tax transactions wasn't rounding discounts properly for returns.

Fixes in 2.7.4:

- Vendor Details & Inventory Details -- Add New was not being allowed except for administrators (even if operator had sufficient access)
- Transactions -- Tax rounding for auto-calculated rates, when adding additional days, was causing different totals to show temporarily.
- New Resvervation & Assign site -- right-clicking and using "Assign this site" was setting the Blockedthru date checkmark.
- New Reservation -- clicking Guarantee without a site selected would assume you want to make it a day pass instead of just an Unassigned reservation.
- Assign Site -- The Guarantee button was not being disabled if the reservation was already guaranteed
- Restore -- If the "Demo" database was open when Restore was done, it could "adjust" all of the dates in a database improperly.

3 Other Changes

Changes in 2.7.3:

- Changed the wording of error messages if the database cannot be read (changed "corrupt" to "damaged").
- Auto-backups are now made of the demo database, in case the file is not renamed before making changes.
- When entering Payments (from Transactions or P.O.S.), if payment method is pre-set to Cash, set focus to Amt Tendered for easier entry.
- Added **Alt-C** shortcut key on P.O.S. dialog to enter a cash payment (enter payment with Cash selected and cursor in Amt Tendered).
- Added "Database version when opened" text on Program Options / Database tab, for diagnostic purposes.
- Allow Ctrl-Tab & Ctrl-Shift-Tab to navigate tab views (in addition to Tab & Shift-Tab without Ctrl), to conform to Windows standards better.
